Rules

We have decided that NSA (North Star Academy) will not have many rules and regulations but request that you adhere to the following:

- 1. Once the children enter the studio that is the start of their lesson, so we request that parents who have any questions to email the teachers out of lesson times, please do not come into a lesson and disrupt the class.
- 2. We expect the children to treat all teachers and each other with respect and extend this expectation to parents too.
- 3. We will NOT accept any form of bullying within the school. If a child is made to feel uncomfortable then please let us know via email, and the relevant action will be taken.
- 4. If you're unhappy with anything in relation to NSA, then please contact us immediately via email so that we can discuss it and come to a solution. Social Media channels and messaging apps should not be used as platforms to discuss negative statements in relation to NSA. Negativity will not be tolerated. Remember we are a cooperative so want to work together as a team.
- 5. If your child is offered a place at NSA, then all fees should be paid for the classes you sign them up for even if they don't attend. We have a waiting list so by taking a spot in class you are obligated as their parent to pay their fees every term.
- 6. Classes can be replaced or cancelled without notice at the discretion of the NSA Teachers. Only cancelled classes will be refunded. No refund will be given for classes that are replaced on any given day, even if your child is unable to attend.
- 7. Classes can be added to your child's schedule at any time throughout the term, however classes can only be dropped at the end of each full term.
- 8. There are four principals at NSA, so please feel free to approach Fiona, Maxine, Louisa, or Sophia with feedback at any time... remember we love receiving good feedback too!

By accepting your place at NSA, you hereby agree to abide by these rules, regulations and policies. This acceptance still stands, after your child graduates, or leaves NSA.

Uniform
